With reference to the above subject, it is to convey that Academic Calendar for the session 2026-27 has been designed with the objective of ensuring structured, balanced, and outcome-oriented academic and co-curricular implementation across all EMRS institutions.

The calendar will serve as a comprehensive execution tool for Principals and teachers by providing clear timelines, reducing ad-hoc planning, strengthening monitoring mechanisms, and aligning institutional activities with national educational priorities such as experiential learning, skill education, and competency-based assessment.

All principals of EMRS are hereby directed to adhere to the following instructions:


1. All activities prescribed for a particular month must be completed within the same month without deviation.
2. After completion of each month, an Action Taken Report (ATR) must be prepared at the school level. The ATR should include:
  - o Brief description of activities conducted
  - o Quantitative participation data
  - o High-quality geo-tagged photographs
3. The compiled ATR must be uploaded on the Google Form link attached with this letter, within 5 days of completion of month.
4. In case any activity could not be conducted due to vacation schedules or unavoidable circumstances, the same must be completed in the subsequent month without fail, with proper justification recorded.
5. A monthly review meeting of lesson plans and academic progress shall be conducted on the last working day of every month.
6. Any activity not explicitly mentioned in the Academic Calendar but mandated or conducted annually as per NESTS guidelines/instructions shall also be carried out by the school. Such activities must be duly documented and included in the monthly Action Taken Report (ATR).

In this regard, it is requested to kindly disseminate the above instruction and Academic Calendar to all respective EMRSs for implementation.
